Fr. Julius and TJF Updates

Back to school!

After a nearly 2-year Covid lockdown, schools reopened in Uganda on January 10, 2022. Fr. Julius, who is healthy and safe, was encouraged that students and teachers could now return to Holy Trinity School. In Fall 2021, TJF sent funds in anticipation of school preparation and food purchases. The economy is also opening back up, so we are hoping that construction on the Science Lab will now resume after having been delayed by Covid restrictions. The Science Lab was built partway when the Covid shut down occurred.

Engineers Without Borders (EWB)

The Carroll College EWB team is looking forward to the next time they will be able to travel to Uganda. The US State Department is not recommending travel to Uganda at this time, so in the meantime the students and mentors are researching sanitation options that would be effective at Holy Trinity School. They have identified improving the latrines for the classes and dormitories as the next highest priority project.

Kitchen improvements

The existing kitchen for the 400 students at Holy Trinity School is a primitive, outdoor, open structure that utilizes a campfire for cooking. A generous donor has provided \$10,000 for an improved kitchen that will be in an enclosed building. The school board had hoped for a future kitchen, so they are now discussing how this will fit into the Master Plan. Fr. Julius said, "Thanks for the nice donations and kind consideration!"
